Dim weight is the weight of a package based on its size rather than "actual weight". UPS, FedEx, and USPS calculate a dim weight for their services and charge the greater of actual scale weight or dim weight to price packages, when applicable. To calculate, you will first determine the package dimensions in inches.

Chargeable weight Rates are based on the total actual weight or the total dimensional weight of all packages in the shipment, whichever is the greater. Any fraction of a kilogram over the weight shown takes the next highest rate. How to determine dimensional weight  $L \times W \times H = \text{Dimensional weight}$  5000 L = length in cms W = width in cms H ...

Compare the package's actual weight to its dimensional weight. The greater of the two is the billable weight and should be used to calculate the rate. For multiple-package shipments, total the billable weight of all packages in the shipment. Refer to the Determine the Weight and Size section of the Rate and Service Guide.

The Impact of Weight and Dimension on UPS Shipping Costs. While weight is a primary factor in UPS shipping rates, dimensional weight often plays a more significant role for larger packages. A lightweight package with substantial dimensions may incur higher shipping costs than a heavier, compact one.

The actual weight is the package weight rounded up to the next whole pound. Use a scale to determine the weight of the package. Round any fraction of a pound to the next whole pound for UPS Express <sup>SM</sup>; Envelopes (letters) over eight ounces and all other packages.

In the example above, the total dimension of the package will be 1,260 cubic inches (12 inches x 15 inches x 7 inches). The formula for finding the dimensional weight is below: Length x Width x Height / Divisor = Dimensional Weight . Or.  $12 \text{ inches} \times 15 \text{ inches} \times 7 \text{ inches} / 139 = 9 \text{ lbs.}$  Actual Weight, Dimensional Weight, and Billable Weight
