

Why is my solar light dimmer?

If the light of your solar light is dimmer than it usually is, there are usually two main things that can be the cause. Either the solar panels aren't absorbing enough solar energy, or the bulb itself is dying. There are a variety of other factors, but these two are the easiest to check quickly.

Why are my solar lights not bright?

If you find that your solar lights are not as bright as they used to be,try changing the angle of the solar panel. Sometimes a slight adjustment can make all the difference.

One of the most common reasons why your solar light isn't working is the wire between the solar panel and the battery. If this wire is broken, then your batteries won't charge no matter what you do.

How to make a solar panel brighter?

The efficiency of charging and therefore extended brightness is enhanced with the best direction of light into the panel. A reflectorcan be created from aluminum foil or even anything painted white paint. The bigger the surface area of reflector, the better as long as it points the light into the panel.

I have five LED bulbs outdoors near the Twin Cities in Minnesota, all of the same brand (Feit 800 lumens, if that matters), which have been installed somewhere around mid-summer 2013. We don't have dimmers, just a bog-standard on/off switch. Four of them work perfectly fine, but the fifth doesn't. It glows dim, while all the others burn brightly.
